
Our Mission

MENTORING PROGRAM

Mary's Mantle launched the new Mentoring Program in 2022, thanks in part to a grant from the Catholic Foundation of Michigan. Long-time staff member Joanna Willis took the lead on program research, the creation of policy and procedures, and program implementation.

The program officially launched in June 2022 has since had the honor of supporting five previous Mary's Mantle moms and their children. Through the program, mentors support moms with a host of experiences and needs. For example, we help families secure housing, navigate changes in employment, develop parenting support, learn to advocate for their children's needs at school, and prepare for childbirth. Mentors have also assisted with researching and sharing concrete, spiritual, and mental health resources for program members as needed. We continue to be their cheerleaders and prayer partners to these moms. Mentors show program participants the love of Christ in action.

An important facet of the Mentor Program is community. To facilitate this community, the program offers opportunities where mentors and mentees can enjoy the company of other moms and their children.

Our goal is to continue to expand the Mentor Program over time so that we can continue to provide this special one-on-one support to more moms in need.





ANIMA CHRISTI FUND

In the beginning of 2022, Mary's Mantle launched The Anima Christi Fund. This donor-directed fund is 100% routed toward helping Mary's Mantle moms, both current and past. The fund's steering committee places strong emphasis on helping past moms who are hoping to bridge an otherwise-insurmountable gap, in order to take next steps on their journey.

Through our generous supporters, Mary's Mantle was able to award more than \$20,000 in 2022 to nine different moms. Funds were used for transportation costs, rent assistance, college tuition, and other concrete needs. The fund continues to have a healthy balance and will continue to support women throughout 2023.



SUNDAY SUPPERS

In June 2022, Mary's Mantle hosted its first Sunday Supper. The goal of this new initiative is to offer a way to foster connection with past moms.

After this first successful event, a volunteer group or family came to the Mary's Mantle home one Sunday each month through November to host a dinner.



Some nights two moms showed up; other times, six moms and all children came. Laughter, good food, prayer, and connection were in abundance. These meals have been fun and meaningul for both the moms and the hosts The ministry looks forward to restarting these wonderful evenings in Spring 2023!
