

Mission:

It has been nearly 3 years since the doors of Mary's Mantle opened welcoming in our first homeless, expectant mothers. Thirty—six months later, blessed with thirty-two women and their babies, we continue to grow in our mission of love. The Lord promises us that the poor will always be with us. What a gift they are. How much we learn as we serve, and how much we grow closer to the Lord by meeting Him each day in these women. I am convinced through this experience, that the road home is paved with simplicity, poverty, sacrifice and love.

What we do:

Mary's Mantle focuses on educating, enriching and encouraging our young moms to become the women God created them to be. Our programming includes: Sexual Integrity classes, Life Coaching, Bible Study, Basic Living Skills instruction and so much more during their year long stay with us. They learn how to parent, how to trust, and how to love and be loved-unconditionally.

New at Mary's Mantle:

We are launching an aftercare program. This program will offer a safety net to those that have completed the program and have transitioned into independent living. It will be an extension of our services focused on preventative and supportive assistance. Home visits, resource referral, small group sessions, counseling and advocacy are just a few things that will be offered to past residents.

Recently one of our residents thanked us ,"for saving her and her daughter". She said if it wasn't for Mary's Mantle they would not be together.
