There are many things that we as staff enjoy about the work that we do, but nothing quite tops watching a woman become a mother. Whether it be the first visit at the hospital, welcoming the mom and baby home for the first time, or a moment three months down the road, it is our honor and privilege to be part of this time in their lives.

We all know parenthood is filled with ups and downs, but we also know what a gift it is. When a woman comes to Mary's Mantle there may be a lot of uncertainty in her life; with that, she may have fear of what type of mother she will be. We want to empower the moms to be the best mom they can be through support, guidance, prayers, and love. Being a mom can be the most challenging role in any woman's life – but also one of the most rewarding.

Since Mary's Mantle started in 2009, the program has been set up to have a live-in House Mother. While every staff position at Mary's Mantle has extreme value, this role, in many ways, is the heart of our program. The House Mother lives in the Mary's Mantle home with the women and creates a community—a home—with each mom that enters our door. The House Mother teaches by example and leads with love.

Mary's Mantle was greatly blessed with the first House Mother, Beverly Anglin, who served in the position from 2009-2015. She laid a solid foundation for the



organization and highlighted the importance of the role. Ms. Beverly is a woman of great faith and deep love, both of which she brought to her responsibilities as House Mother. To this day, she maintains contact with many of the moms and children of Mary's Mantle, providing

support, love, and guidance.

At this time, we are happy to announce that Judy Statchura has been hired and moved in as the next House Mother at Mary's Mantle. Ms. Judy is a mom of two adult sons, has a deep faith, and has been a pediatric nurse for over 40 years. She is kind, compassionate, and has a great sense of humor. She shared the following on coming to Mary's Mantle:

"I have always felt that children are our future and it's our job to teach and show them God's love. I remember the Bible story when Jesus called the little children to be at his side. My dad was my role model; when we had family gatherings he was always with the kids laughing, playing his guitar or harmonica, and singing with them. He was always there showing love toward children. As a nurse, I have devoted my life to moms and new babies. We have so much we can show them. The greatest of all the things we can teach is to LOVE.
