Since we strive to protect all human dignity - including the privacy and safety of our residents - most of our supporters don't have access to the beautiful nitty-gritty of life at Mary's Mantle. That's good and important, but it's also a bit of a pity, because the daily details can be pretty amazing. For example, on Wednesday, November 19, 2025 at the house...

Our spiritual coordinator arrived to a just-waking household to meet online with her MM intercessory prayer team. Meanwhile, a support staff member checked on each resident and accompanied them in their early-morning routines.

The staff gathered for their quarterly meeting, enjoying quiche, fruit, and coffee while receiving updates and discussing different ways to engage with the residents. A support staff member mentioned that she's helping them create their own beauty products.

Mom A entered the meeting and asked our executive director to hold her infant for a while, a task she cheerfully managed. The sweet infant made use of her diaper and was eventually passed back to Mom.

After the meeting, our controller stuck around to sort out financial details from the Gala, and our office manager opened an envelope containing a surprisingly large donation from someone we don't even know. She also reported that the dryer repairman who had visited the night before learned about our work and refused to charge us.

Our case manager took Mom B to her ultrasound appointment. All is well - 33 weeks and counting!

Mom B and Mom C used coloring books while working on some spiritual goals at the kitchen table. Mom C mentioned that she

decided to deliberately pray to the God she has long believed in to help her find a better place for her baby to be born than in a car on the side of an off-ramp. The next day, she connected with Mary's Mantle in what she describes as a miracle.

Mom B confirmed plans with our director of client services to take advantage of the sacrament of reconciliation with Father J.J. Mech, who is one of Mary's Mantle's founders. Mom B also shared about some of the profound losses she experienced through a house fire.

Mom D stayed quiet, processing some important legal issues. Her meeting with the spiritual coordinator did coax forward some healthy tears, though.

While the case manager and director of client services attended a training webinar, our after care coordinator met virtually with past residents to discuss goal achievement. Others finished clean-up from the recent Gala. Our executive director managed prize deliveries to the auction winners.

Mom A and her baby enjoyed a session with our in-house photography pro (who is also our office manager!) while Mom C drove herself to a prenatal appointment.

After a lovely dinner, the residents and a support staff member prayed together, watched a movie, and discussed different outings they could plan. The staff member reported, "Overall it was a wonderful night."

Overall, it always is.
