
Dear Mary's Mantle Supporters,

The moms in our After Care program have been busy as well. All women in the program have regular home visits from their Mary's Mantle worker, who helps them continue to set and achieve goals once they move out of the residential program. Recently, one of our After Care moms received a promotion to a management positon at the direct care company where she works. Two other moms have enrolled in courses to further their education. Yet another mom secured a new job and purchased her own vehicle.
